After many years of fan demand, Randy Bachman and Fred Turner, two giants of rock n' roll, are finally reuniting for the first time in more than 20 years. The musicians at the heart of legendary Canadian rock band Bachman-Turner Overdrive, **Bachman & Turner**, will be bringing their hit tunes to the casino on October 16th. In the mid 70s there was no one bigger than Bachman-Turner Overdrive. They notched hits like "You Ain't Seen Nothing Yet," "Taking Care of Business" and "Let It Ride," in over 20 countries.

Al Green will bring soul to the Coachella Valley this October 22 during a performance at the Casino's Showroom. Having been inducted into the Gospel Music Hall of Fame, hitting the Rolling Stones Top 100 Artists of all time and producing over a dozen top singles, Al Green's music has continued to touch and impact all genres of music.
