Blue Bar Identification Requirements

The following identification requirements are to be used in the Blue Bar effective immediately. These guidelines were written to assist the officers assigned to the Blue Bar in determining if a patron is in compliance with the Identification requirements set forth by Spotlight 29 Casino's management. These guidelines include examples of legally acceptable I.D. and examples of unacceptable I.D.'s. The Blue Bar identification requirements should be enforced on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays. The Watch Commander on duty/or Casino Management has the right to adjust this enforcement policy as deemed appropriate to accommodate business on Sundays. Management also has the right to implement the identification requirement on any day of the week.

- I. **All patrons must show bona fide (legally acceptable I.D. An I.D. is legally acceptable if it:**
 - A. Is issued by a *governmental agency* (such as federal, state, county or city).
 - B. Contains the *name* of the person.
 - C. Contains the *date of birth* of the person
 - D. Contains a *physical description* of the person
 - E. Contains a *photograph* of the person
 - F. Is currently *valid* (not expired)

- II. **Examples of legally acceptable I.D.'s are:**
 - A. Driver's License
 - B. State-issued I.D. card

- III. **Examples of unacceptable I.D.'s are:**
 - A. Temporary driver's licenses
 - B. Non-photo driver's licenses
 - C. Birth Certificates, school or work I.D. cards
